



**SPANISH SCREENINGS ANÍMATE 2022
CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS**

**SUBMISSION DEADLINE
19 September 2022**

As part of the Spain, European Audiovisual Hub Plan and through the funding of Component 25 (Spain Audiovisual Hub) of the Recovery, Transformation and Resilience Plan, a Spanish audiovisual production market will be promoted, which will hold its Spanish Screenings On Tour edition in the framework of the Ventana Sur Market, Argentina, from 28 November to 2 December 2022.

This call is for Spanish animation projects in feature film or series format at the development or pre-production stage. Representatives of the Spanish Screenings On Tour and Ventana Sur will make a selection of up to 5 projects. The projects selected for Spanish Screenings Animate will be presented out of competition in the context of Animation! at Ventana Sur 2022.

Pitching Sessions:

These will take place from 28 November to 2 December at the Ventana Sur Market. During the sessions, the representatives of each project will have the opportunity to pitch and promote their projects to industry professionals.

CONDITIONS FOR PRESENTING PROJECTS

- The same production company can present projects in the series and feature film categories.
- The projects must be at the development or pre-production stage.
- They must be Spanish projects or co-productions with a majority Spanish partner.
- Projects open to international co-production, especially with Ibero-American countries (<https://www.segib.org/paises/>), will be taken into account when making the selection.
- Priority will be given to projects that have at least 20% of their budget assured and projects with potential interest for the international market.
- Projects selected for previous editions of the Animation! section at Ventana Sur will not be accepted.
- In the case of mixed productions (live action and animation), only projects with at least 50% animation will be considered.
- The projects can be presented by the directors or the producers.
- Only projects for which all of the required documentation (registration form and required documentation) has been presented prior to the deadline will be considered, no matter what the category.
- In the case of series, the project must not have been acquired beforehand by a TV channel or platform.
- The deadline for submitting material is Monday, 19 September.

SELECTION AND SUPPORT

- The representatives of Spanish Screenings On Tour and Ventana Sur will select up to a total of 5 projects.
- The selected projects will be announced in mid-October.
- The finalist projects will be part of the Spanish Screenings Animate selection to be presented in the Animation! section of Ventana Sur. The representatives of each project will have the opportunity to pitch and promote their projects to the international industry professionals accredited at the event.
- Each project will receive a maximum of two accreditations for Ventana Sur 2022, one of which must be for the main producer of the project.

- The organisers of Spanish Screenings On Tour will provide one plane ticket for the main producer of the project and 5 nights' accommodation in a double room with breakfast per project.
- Both the pitch and all exchanges with professionals will be carried out in Spanish and English.
- Additionally to preparation of the pitch on-site, each selected party must submit a video pitch for their project before 7 November 2022.

VIDEO PITCH

- Those representing the selected projects will receive guidelines and will have access to advisory sessions with experts on how to make the video pitch.
- The video pitch must be submitted by 7 November 2022 at the latest, respecting the following technical specifications:
 - Frame rate: 24 img/sec or 25 img/sec or 30 img/sec
 - Video output: Constant Bite Rate (CBR) mini 10 Mbps, maxi16
 - Mbps Audio channels: Stereo Audio codec: AAC Audio output: mini 256Kbps, maxi 512Kbps
 - Language: English with Spanish subtitles
 - Maximum length: 6 minutes
- Please note that video pitches failing to meet any of the indications or submitted after the deadline will not be taken into consideration.
- The video pitches will be shown on the Spanish Screenings and Ventana Sur online platforms, and will be available for accredited guests during Ventana Sur 2022.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Project registration is free of charge.
- All of the selected projects and the information about their authors will appear on the Spanish Screenings, Animation! and Ventana Sur websites and social media.
- The information and images submitted may be used in promotional material for Animation! and/or Ventana Sur, and Spanish Screenings.
- All circumstances not envisaged in these terms and conditions will be settled by the organisers of the Spanish Screenings On Tour.
- The organisation reserves the right to revoke the decision of the jury if considered necessary.
- Acceptance of these terms and conditions authorises Animation!, Ventana Sur and Spanish Screenings to reproduce and publish, at no cost, the graphic and audiovisual materials provided during the registration process in its social media and communications.
- Registering to submit a project implies the acceptance of these terms and conditions and the undertaking to guarantee the presence of a representative at the event if the project is selected.

DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION

A_ Online form.

B_ Additional documentation:

- Project dossier, including the artistic approach and graphic development of the animation.
- Plot treatment (max. 10 pages).
- Budget summary in euros and dollars.
- Financing plan in euros and dollars (including assured financing and its sources).

- Motivational letter from the producer (max. 2 pages).
- A progress chart for the project describing the status of the production and its timeline.
- A document signed by the director and producer accrediting their copyright of the work.
